ChemClear® collects from persons, businesses and organisations undertaking:

Agricultural and livestock production; Industrial and recreational pest and weed control; Forestry; similar activities conducted by local, state and federal Gov Agencies.

The program is targeted to meet disposal requirements of agvet chemical users, and, whilst doing so divert potential hazardous chemicals from being dumped in landfills, creeks or being inappropriately disposed of.

FOR THE COLLECTION OF UNWANTED AGVET CHEMICALS

ChemClear is an industry stewardship program which is funded to collect currently registered agricultural and veterinary chemicals at the end of their life cycle, or, when they become surplus or unwanted.

The appropriate collection and disposal of these chemicals minimises their impact on the environment if otherwise left unattended. The service ensures that these possible environmental contaminants are retrieved and in turn reduces waste and the possibility of residual contamination.

Invitation to Participate

We invite Local Governments to participate in the ChemClear Program by providing a Host Collection Site. The objective is to work in partnership with Councils to provide a suitable agvet collection service for their community. Waste holders who have registered for our service are provided with an appointment time to drop of their booked in chemicals direct to our retrieval team set up on a Council Host Site.

Getting Involved

We don't ask Councils to sort, store, handle or hold any chemical waste on behalf of our program.



To get involved Councils are required to complete a *Host Site Nomination Form* for the site they deem appropriate for ChemClear to set up at and operate from during any scheduled collection campaign.

Communications

ChemClear provides Councils with:

- A ChemClear metal sign to place at their nominated site/s;
- Campaign ads and media releases to place in Council's communications in the lead up to a collection:
- Promotional materials;
- Reports on waste collected from the Council at the conclusion of the campaign.
